Questions of Covenant Partners (Members)

1. Do you acknowledge yourself to be a sinner in the sight of God, justly deserving God's displeasure and without hope except in His sovereign mercy?
2. Do you believe in the Lord Jesus Christ as the Son of God and Savior of sinners, and do you receive and rest upon Him alone for your salvation as He is offered in the Gospel?
3. Do you receive the Essential Tenants and Confessions of the church as reliable expositions of what Scripture leads us to do and believe, and will you be guided by those tenants as a faithful witness to Jesus Christ?
4. Do you now resolve and promise in the humble reliance upon the grace of the Holy Spirit, that you will live as a follower and disciple of Jesus Christ?
5. Do you promise to support the church in its worship and its ministry to the best of your ability?
6. Do you submit yourself to the government and discipline of the church, and promise to further its purity and peace?

Inasmuch as you have made a profession (or reaffirmation) of your faith, have received the Sacrament of Baptism, and have by the Session been approved for active church membership, I declare you entitled to all the privileges of this congregation and the church universal, and that you have all the duties and responsibilities incumbent upon those who profess Christ and seek to worship God by service to God and ministry to others.
